Re: Optima Health: Letter of Commitment to the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi)

Dear SBTi,

Optima Health is committed to playing its part in tackling the global climate crisis and supporting the transition to a Net Zero future. As a trusted partner to the UK National Health Service (NHS), we recognise the urgent need to align our business operations with the most robust climate science and to demonstrate leadership in decarbonisation across the healthcare sector.

We hereby commit to setting near-term and long-term greenhouse gas (GHG) reduction targets in line with the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi). Specifically, we will:

Develop near-term targets to reduce our Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions in line with a 1.5°C trajectory, and our Scope 3 emissions in line with the well-below 2°C trajectory, with the ambition of strengthening Scope 3 reductions to 1.5°C as data quality improves.
Set a long-term Net Zero target, committing Optima Health to achieve Net Zero across our entire value chain by 2040, reducing absolute Scope 1, 2, and 3 emissions by at least 90% from our 2023 baseline before neutralising any residual emissions through the procurement of carbon credits or investment into carbon offsetting projects.
Ensure that our commitments are consistent with SBTi criteria and guidelines and submit our targets for validation within 24 months of this commitment.

In making this commitment, we acknowledge the need for transparency, accountability, and annual reporting of our progress against these targets. We also recognise that addressing Scope 3 emissions is a priority for Optima Health, as they represent the majority of our carbon footprint, and we will work closely with our suppliers and partners to ensure meaningful reductions.

By aligning with the SBTi, Optima Health will strengthen its alignment with NHS Net Zero requirements, enhance the resilience of our business, and reinforce our role as a leader in sustainable healthcare services.

We appreciate your consideration and look forward to working with the SBTi to validate and implement our science-based targets.
